("Pay as You Throw" for additional waste)

Roy Strom also offers a downsized service option to most areas in DuPage County. This new 64 gallon version of the Dual Collect program better accommodates senior citizens, those that do not need the capacity the standard 96 gallon Dual Collect format offers, or those that do not have the space or need for the larger containers, but appreciate the Dual Collect program concept.



Here's how the clean easy disposal solution works for you!

- Each residence is provided (2) two 64 gallon carts: one for household **Refuse (brown lid)**, and one for **Recyclables (blue lid)**!
- **Refuse** and **Recyclables** are collected with efficient fully-automated equipment or split body semi-automated collection trucks.
- Each "Dual Collect" cart has a serial number. The carts delivered to you will be assigned to your address for inventory and maintenance purposes. Fully automated equipment will literally pick up the carts, therefore, residents are asked to set their "Dual Collect" carts out approximately **3 feet a part** from each other, and **away from objects like** (mail boxes, trees, poles, parked vehicles, and other items placed out for collection). **Handles** should always **face towards the house - away from the street**.
- Household **Refuse** including any junk items that can be placed in the cart with the lid closed will be accepted. Hazardous waste and materials prohibited by State law will not. **Additional waste may be disposed of by placing a pre-purchased Universal Solid Waste Tag on each additional container, not exceeding 32 gallon capacity, weighing no more than 50 pounds. Tags which are \$2.50 each are available at the convenient retail locations listed below.**

- **Commingled Recyclables** can be placed in the "blue lid" cart.
 - **Aluminum** containers (beverage/food) rinsed
 - **Glass** containers (beverage and food - green/clear/brown) rinsed
 - **Bi-Metal** containers (soup, juice, etc.) rinsed / empty paint - aerosol containers
 - **Newsprint** (anything paper that comes with / in a newspaper)
 - **Chipboard/Corrugated** (cereal/food boxes, gift/shoe boxes, etc.), broken down large boxes etc.
 - **Mixed Paper** (junk mail, envelopes, phone books, office/notebook, computer, white or colored paper that does not have metal fasteners attached to it, magazines and catalogs, paper grocery bags)
 - **Plastics: Any plastic container with:**



(Plastic milk/water/juice jugs, two liter beverage bottles, laundry detergent, liquor/ other food containers, etc.)



- **Yard waste / bundled brush** weighing no more than 50 pounds may be disposed of by placing a pre-purchased Yard Waste Collection Tag on each 32 gallon "Kraft" paper yard waste bag, container not exceeding 32 gallon capacity, or brush bundles not exceeding 4 ft. in length or 4" in diameter. **Tags are \$2.50 each.** In 1990 yard waste was banned from landfills in Illinois. **Yard Waste must be collected / processed separately.**

- Bulk or large items (refrigerator, washer/dryer, TV, couch, etc.) and home remodeling debris (wood, paneling, carpet, plumbing fixtures, etc.) will be collected by special pick up.

COLLECTION REMINDERS

"A Little Space Please"

Don't forget: carts should be set out approximately 3 feet from each other, sign posts, trees, mailboxes, cars, or other containers, and with the handles facing away from the street. By doing so collection is more efficient and spillage is minimized!"



HOLIDAY PICK UP SCHEDULE

The following Holiday scheduled is observed. Service is not provided on the holidays listed. Should a holiday fall on a week day (Monday through Friday) there will be no collection on that day. Collection will be the following day and one day later for the remainder of the collection days that week.

There will be no service provided on the following holidays:

- **New Years Day**
- **Memorial Day**
- **Fourth of July**
- **Labor Day**
- **Thanksgiving Day**
- **Christmas Day**

Collection Day after a holiday always occurs one day later.

Yard Waste Collection Program Schedule

Yard waste material collection begins the first full week in April, and runs through the last full week in November each year. This is consistent with what is done throughout our service area. In Illinois, yard waste; leaves, brush, etc., cannot legally be disposed of in a land fill. Compost / land application sites typically close by December 1.
